

THE COLBY CEMETERY

THIS SMALL CEMETERY SITS ATOP A HILL ON THE JUNCTION ROAD OVERLOOKING THE WINOOSKI RIVER, INTERSTATE 89 AND ROUTE TWO. ACROSS THE RIVER IS THE TOWN OF MIDDLESEX. THESE STONES SHOW THE RAVAGES OF TIME AND POLLUTION. IN A FEW MORE YEARS ALL INFORMATION ON THE STONES MAY BE LOST. THERE IS A CRUDE FENCE AROUND THE CEMETERY BUT NEEDS SOME REPAIR.

TO REACH THIS LITTLE CEMETERY, START UP THE MONTPELIER ACCESS ROAD BEARING RIGHT AT THE ROAD TO THE JUNCTION. FOLLOW THIS ROAD ABOUT TWO MILES. THE CEMETERY IS ON THE LEFT AND VERY HARD TO SEE FROM THE ROAD. A ROAD TURNS OFF JUST BEFORE A GREEN HOUSE AND ACROSS THE ROAD IS ANOTHER HOUSE. TURN UP THE ROAD A SHORT DISTANCE AND AT THE Y TURN RIGHT. THE CEMETERY IS ON YOUR RIGHT AND YOU CAN PARK ON A GRASSY AREA BELOW THE CEMETERY. IN 2007 THE LISTINGS WERE CAREFULLY CHECKED AND MEMBERS OF THE BERLIN HISTORICAL SOCIETY TOOK PHOTOS OF EACH MONUMENT. A NEW NUMBERING SYSTEM WAS DEVELOPED WHICH CONFORMS WITH MAPS PREPARED BY THE BERLIN CEMETERY COMMISSION. THESE MAPS AND PHOTOS ARE AVAILABLE ON REQUEST AND THE MAPS MAY SOON BE ADDED TO THE INFORMATION ON THE TOWN WEB PAGE.
