

## **DEWEY-WRIGHT CEMETERY**

THIS IS A BEAUTIFUL CEMETERY ON ROWELL HILL, OFF ROUTE 12 IN THE DOG RIVER VALLEY. THIS CEMETERY IS FENCED BUT THE FENCE ON THE LOWER SIDE ALONG THE EMBANKMENT HAS BEGUN TO SLIP DOWN THE HILL.

ROWELL HILL IS TWO AND ONE HALF MILES FROM MONTPELIER, SOUTH TOWARD NORTHFIELD. IT TURNS LEFT OFF THE NORTHFIELD ROAD (ROUTE 12). CROSSES THE DOG RIVER AND THE RAILROAD TRACKS AND CONTINUES ON UP THE HILL.

THERE IS A WOODEN DOUBLEGATE INTO THE CEMETERY FROM THE ROAD (NOT ACCESSABLE BECAUSE OF THE ROAD DITCH) AND A SIMPLE ROADWAY RUNS THROUGH TO THE BACK SIDE DIVIDING THE CEMETERY INTO TWO SECTIONS.

IN 2007 THE LISTINGS WERE CAREFULLY CHECKED AND MEMBERS OF THE BERLIN HISTORICAL SOCIETY TOOK PHOTOS OF EACH MONUMENT. A NEW NUMBERING SYSTEM WAS DEVELOPED WHICH CONFORMS WITH MAPS PREPARED BY THE BERLIN CEMETERY COMMISSION.
