

## COX BROOK ROAD CEMETERY, BERLIN, VERMONT

Purported to be if not the oldest cemetery in town definitely one of the oldest. To find the Cox Brook Road Cemetery you take Route 12 south from Montpelier to Northfield Falls. Turn west on the Cox Brook Road (at the falls general store - cross block), go through the three covered bridges. Go approximately one and one half miles and take a right turn on to Glinnes Road. The cemetery is on the left on the property owned by the John Maloney's. This is a small cemetery surrounded by a fence. Large over grown shrubs in center hide some of the stones.

2. Amanda, relict of C. W. Jackson, died June 21, 1852. Aged 39 years.
5. Charles W. Jackson died April 13, 1847. Age 35 yrs. This stone lays flat and is partially overgrown.
6. Caleb M. Kimball died, October 12, 1852. Age 44 years 9 months.
7. Almira M. Kimball, wife of Caleb M. Kimball, died January 7, 1844. Age 34 years.
8. Susan M. Harwood, died May 10, 1849. 18 yrs. 7 mos.
12. James S., son of L. F. & L. I. Buzzell, Died May 28, 1857. 5 months 20 days.
13. Lilah J., dau. of L. F. & L. I. Buzzell, died April 26, 1859. Age 1 mo. 11 da.
14. Keziah Hatchett, died January 27, 1831. Age 31 years.
15. Angeline M., daughter Henry Hatchett, died, June 1839
20. Charlotte, wife of Wm. Buzzell, died March 1, 1865. Age 68 yrs.
21. Susan, wife of Henry Crane, died March 28, 1868. Age 57 years.
22. George W., son of Henry and Susan Crane, died, April 4, 1868. Age 27 years.
23. William, son of Henry and Susan Crane, died, March 1838. Age 4 months.
25. Drisy M., dau. of J. J. & M. Bell, died, December 23, 1885. Age 7 years.
29. Sally, wife of Samuel Foster died Feb 21, 1854
30. In memory of Samuel Foster who died July 13, 1831 aged 52 years
32. Albina, daughter of A. H. Clark, died Sept. 23, 1855. Age 13 months.
37. David F., son of George E. & W. A. Rich, died March 9, 1833. Age 10 days.
38. Luvia M., dau. of George E. & W. A. Rich, died December 15, 1851. 3 months, 15 days.
