

## WEST BERLIN CEMETERY BERLIN VERMONT

The West Berlin Cemetery is on Route 12 about halfway between Montpelier and Northfield. It is in the Berlin section known as Riverton. It is a private cemetery whose records are at present in the hands of Attorney Norbert Towne, who is supposed to be readying deeds, etc. to turn the cemetery over to the town. This has been done.

This is a pleasant cemetery which drops off on three sides to a field and the Dog River. There are trees and shrubs and some interesting old stones. Along the front facing the road is a series of granite posts at one time connected by chains. There appears to be two drives from front to back. Stones have been listed from left to right starting at left front of cemetery. I have made notations where there are trees and bushes.
