

Snowmobile Information for Irish Hill

The East Darling Trail and the Ridgeline Trail in the Berlin Conservation Area on Irish Hill will be opened to snowmobiles for the 2021-2022 season. A map of the snowmobile route and trail conditions, including openings and closures for snowmobiles, can be found at vtvast.org/trails.html.

These are shared trails. Hikers, skiers, families with children, dogs and snowmobiles may be encountered anywhere along the way while in the Berlin town forests. Snowmobilers should travel at a speed that allows them plenty of room to see other visitors and to stop or slow down as needed. If pedestrians move to the right side of the trail, snowmobiles can pass to the left. Dogs should be under voice control or leashed. Please share and enjoy this trail in a safe and friendly manner.

VAST membership is required for snowmobilers to use the trail, and snowmobilers may only ride on mapped and opened VAST trails. Riding on private land requires written permission from the owner. Riding off-trail in the Berlin town forests is not allowed.
