Results from the Town Meeting Day voting – all items on the Town ballot passed this includes the Town budget of \$3,807,810.00, the exemption for the Grange, and ALL the special appropriations. Carl Parton and Joe Staab are being welcomed onto the Selectboard. 565 from our checklist voted with 196 of those being in person. Details can be found on the Town website

All items on the Washington Central Unified Union School District ballot passed which included Article 6, the budget of \$36,169,267.00 for all six schools and Article 9 for the 3.8 acres of Berlin Elementary School land to be given to the Town of Berlin with 1810 yes, 770 no, 291 undervotes (blanks), and 3 overvotes.
