Fisher Road continues to be closed until May 16th for reconstruction work and paving from Paine Turnpike N to the top of the hill.

Reminder that the final quarterly tax payment is due on or before May 15th.

To make payments you can:

*bring your payment to the treasurer or leave it in the deposit box outside the treasurer's door (to the far left of the Town office building when you're facing it)

*mail it to 108 Shed Road, Berlin, VT 05602 and as long as it's postmarked by the US Postal Service by the 15th it will be honored as being on time (not an office meter)

*pay online, although there is a fee charged to do so (<http://www.berlinvt.org/make-payment>)

Payments not made on time incur a late fee of 8% penalty and 1% interest (even if it's just one day late). If unable to make the entire payment, consider a partial payment to help lessen the late fees.
